All cars must carry a fully charged fire extinguisher. Any car without a fire extinguisher will not be permitted on the field. All cars must be insured by owner. All cars must stay on the field until after the 3pm awards presentation.

Founded in 1963, the La Jolla Historical Society serves as an advocate for La Jolla's heritage by discovering, collecting and preserving the community's historical documentation, artifacts, sites, and structures. The organization is committed to increasing the community's awareness and appreciation of its heritage by providing access to and interpreting its collection for the public.

The Society boasts more than 1,200 members and is a multi-faceted 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization with a growing list of dynamic programs and an ambitious future. In July 2008, the Society was gifted the three historic buildings on the site of what was once the estate of Ellen Browning Scripps, including historic Wisteria Cottage, a 1909 beach cottage that serves as the Society's current headquarters, and the adjacent 1895 carriage house. Future Current plans call for the renovation of the property to serve as the Society's future new home, featuring exhibition galleries, an educational center, gift shop, staff offices, and modern archival storage. The Society is in the midst of a multi-million dollar capital campaign to raise funds for the restoration of the three structures.
